What We Do

SMI is engaged in providing assistance in practical ways to those in great need. Our efforts are currently concentrated on the land of Haiti. Our ministries and projects are often carried out in conjunction with missionaries in the field or other organizations committed to a similar purpose. Through a variety of projects SMI is making a difference in the daily lives of Haitians living in the Arcahaie area north of Port Au Prince.

Mission Trip Hosting

The 12,000 square foot mission house in Guitton serves as a base for groups participating in service projects. SMI provides ministry opportunities for groups and individuals desiring to spend time in Haiti personally ministering to the Haitian people. Construction

SMI has participated in the construction of mission facilities, churches, schools and homes. A new church building and a children's building have been completed in Nanwòch, and a new church/school building has been completed in Guitton.

Medical/Dental Clinics

The medical/dental clinics provide the opportunity for medical and support personnel from the States to minister to the physical needs of the Haitian people, most of whom do not have access to regular health care or medical facilities. Clinics are usually held in village churches throughout Haiti.

Youth Ministry

For the past four years SMI has provided the opportunity for Haitian youth to join with American youth for several days of worship, teaching, fellowship and sports activities.

Orphanage

SMI has assumed the oversight of an orphanage in Bon Repos. The orphanage currently serves 64 children. A new dorm/multipurpose building which provides sleeping, dining and meeting facilities has recently been completed.

School Sponsorship

A new school, Canaan Lekòl, was started in Guitton in 2010 and 180 students were enrolled in the fall of 2014 in K4-6th grades. A contribution of \$300 a year will pay for a student to attend school and purchase uniforms, books and supplies for the 2014-2015 school year.

Feeding/Clothing Programs

Groups who participate in an SMI hosted mission trip have the opportunity to distribute food and clothing in local villages.

Women's Ministry

Since 2007 SMI has hosted conferences at the Pastors' Retreat Center in Saintard and in local churches for 100-120 women who come for three days of "Seminary." The women have the opportunity to worship together, study the Word of God, receive health and hygiene instruction, make crafts and enjoy their sisters in Christ. SMI also sponsors a prenatal/early childhood education program designed to provide mothers with the information and resources to have healthy pregnancies and to care for their newborn.

Future Plans

In addition to continuing the ministries above, during 2015 SMI will focus on helping complete the new sanctuary in St. Ard. Through our SMI Haitian Community Partnership program SMI is expanding its ministry into neighboring villages, planting churches and providing the infrastructure necessary to equip a Haitian-led ministry to meet the spiritual and physical needs in each village.
